NOTES FROM THE NCCDL/NCLC MEETING FOR 2015 SCHEDULING

NCCDL and NCLC: The NCCDL will operate with either a 13-team or 14-team league, using the Central vs. Peripheral style of divisions that we have employed in odd-numbered years for a while now. The 13 teams are the same as this year, and the possible 14th is a very outside-chance possibility of Fuquay-Varina returning (the divisions do not change regardless of whether Fuquay-Varina does/doesn't play). The Central division will include Piedmont, Chapel Hill, Durham, Raleigh, Cary, and Capital Area (and Fuquay-Varina if that team happens to re-form). The Mountain/Beach division will include Asheville, Pineville, Charlotte, Lake Norman, Jacksonville, Wilmington, and Port City. Unlike in past years with this alignment, the NCCDL captains (like the NCLC captains) voted to not include any intra-divisional matches. Thus, Central teams will play 7 matches and the Mountain/Beach teams will play 6 matches (or 7 if Fuquay-Varina re-forms), with all matches during the regular season being inter-divisional. == The NCLC will operate with 12 teams (as Cary has added an NCLC team for this coming year) in a similar division format, with the following team groupings (since some leagues have only an NCCDL team OR an NCLC team): Piedmont/Chapel Hill/Apex/Cary/Capital Area/Fuquay-Varina, and Asheville/Hickory/Pineville/Charlotte/Jacksonville/Wilmington. The NCLC will play only the inter-divisional opponents as well, meaning each team will have 6 matches.
